Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our topic learning about 'Why do we like art?', we have arranged for our Year 5 children to participate in a screen printing workshop at Whitefriars School. This workshop will be delivered by the artist Tim Davies, an outside provider, and it will give the children the opportunity to learn screen printing techniques and create their own printed tote bag which they will then get to take home. This visit will take place on **Wednesday 12th December 2018**; this is an exciting opportunity for your child to extend their topic learning in a real-life context.

As screen printing involves materials that can stain clothing, we strongly advise all children to bring in an old shirt to cover their clothing on the day of the workshop.

Parents are asked to make a voluntary contribution of **£8.00** towards the cost of this visit; the price includes the cost of the workshop and the materials including the tote bag which are provided by the guest artist. Unfortunately, I have to point out that failure to raise the required amount will mean cancellation of the visit.
