Dear Year 3 Parents and Carers,

Our topic for the next half term is *'What's The Point of Chocolate?'* when we will be exploring the history of chocolate. We have invited the Chocolate Museum into school on **Wednesday 12th December** to enable the children to understand more about the production of chocolate and how the trade helps developing countries. The workshop will allow the children to experience different flavours of chocolate and learn about how chocolate is made, packaged and distributed. Children will be making their own chocolate samples to take with them - it'll be a morning filled with thoroughly enjoyable and informative activities!
