Year 4 trip to London Science Museum

As a part of our topic 'States of Matter', we have arranged for our Year 4 children to visit the London Science Museum on Wednesday 13th March 2019. The trip will consist of a Science show and an opportunity to enter the Wonderlab where there are over 50 exhibits for children to explore. Prior to both, children will have the chance to explore an aspect of the museum to further fuel their learning on the changes of different states of matter.

On the day your child will need:

- School Uniform
- Other clothing according to the weather - sunhat, a raincoat with hood etc (N.B Sun cream should be applied before the trip).
- Children should bring a packed lunch with no breakable containers or canned drinks please.

If your child normally receives a **free** hot meal then a packed lunch will be provided.
If you pay for school meals then you must provide a pack lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from **travel sickness** please give him/her any necessary **medication** before s/he comes to school on the morning of the trip and if necessary a spare to his/her teacher for the return journey. If your child does need travel sickness medication for the return journey please be sure to fill out a medication consent form available from the school office.

We expect to return to school by 3pm. Information about the trip including updates re delays etc. will be available from the School Office (020 8427 2080).

There is no cost for this trip. We will be walking to Harrow and Wealdstone station and travelling via tube to South Kensington station.
