


Nursery Autumn Term Newsletter September 2021



Dear Parents and Carers,

Some important reminders

Arriving and leaving school:

Please make sure that all clothing and items that belongs to your child are labelled with permanent ink e.g., coats, sweat shirts, cardigans, shoes, scarves, hats, gloves, wellington boots, water bottles and book-bags.
