Dear Parents and Carers,

From today (Thursday 24th February), the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test has been removed. From today (Thursday 24th February) the Government continues to advise children who test positive to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for five full days. They can return to school when they receive two negative test results on consecutive days. (The first test is on day 5 which means the first potential day back at school is day 6). Regardless of the test result, they can return to school after ten full days of isolation.

If children have Coronavirus symptoms, the advice is to still self-isolate, book a PCR test and isolate until the results are known. Please report the child's absence to the school in the usual manner.

The government has removed the guidance for secondary aged pupils to undertake twice weekly asymptomatic testing.
